• Executive Director

- Mike Anzuini put together proposed by-law addition for executive director
- Honorarium will be determined every 2 years, in conjunction with our usual officer voting.
- Motion: Send an electronic vote to the general membership with the purposes of adding an executive director to the executive board.
 Amendment as follows:
 - ARTICLE V Executive Committee and Board of Directors, Section 5.
 - The Executive committee shall appoint a member of NJAJE to serve as its Executive director. The Executive Director shall be a member of the Executive Committee and the Board of directors. Duties of the Executive Director shall include, but not be limited to, Membership, organization and execution of the performance festivals, webmaster and any other duties as deemed by the President.
 - The term of the Executive Director shall be for two years. The Executive Director shall begin their term of office July 1, in the year of the election.
 - The Board of Directors shall vote upon an agreeable honorarium paid to the person who fulfills the duties of the Executive Director. The amount of the honorarium shall be set and voted upon at the Spring meeting of the election year. The Honorarium shall be paid in equal installments prior to each meeting of the Board of Directors.
- Pending approval of the change of the by-laws to make the honorarium \$3,000 for the term – breaking down to \$500 at each meeting, over 2 years.
